



The following describes how to properly package devices for return. We ask you to follow these instructions step by step, as otherwise unintentional transport damage may occur due to improper packaging.



Our transport packaging is usually delivered flat.

- 1. Unfold the box and place it on the floor with the top opening facing down (Fig. 2a.).
- Now fold the inner short side pieces (Fig. 2b.) inwards on both sides and place the longer side pieces (Fig. 2c.) over the short side pieces.
- 3. Stick the first strip of parcel tape over the folded long side parts.
- We recommend to use at least 3 sheets of parcel tape for securing.








ATTENTION: Proven transport damages due to improper or insufficient transport packaging are at the expense of the sender.








ATTENTION: Please note that the display must be specially protected against damage. For this purpose we recommend to pull the original protective foil over the device and, if necessary, to put a piece of cardboard in front of the display.









packaging and, if necessary, place the device in the recesses provided for this purpose. Make sure that the device has enough space left and right to the packaging.

Protect the top side by inserting the two remaining transport pads (Fig. 6a.)

7. In case of reverse transaction (DOA), please always include all supplied accessories with the device. Make sure that the accessories in a bag on the back of the display are not placed in front of the display. Devices that are intended for warranty processing (repair) are always sent in without accessories.







ATTENTION: Make sure that all accessories to protect the display are included with the unit at the rear of the unit.



- 8. Always protect and pack the device base separately. Enclose it together with the accessories at the rear of the device.
- Now fold the inner short side pieces of both sides inwards again and place the longer side pieces over the short side pieces.
- Stick the first strip of parcel tape over the folded long side parts.
 We also recommend to use at least 3 strips of parcel tape for the top side to secure it.
